At-cost dental treatment is treatment that is not covered by regulation or contract. We pay for at-cost treatment for covered dental claims at what we consider to be a fair and reasonable cost.

The criteria used to determine liability for at-cost treatment is set out in the AC Act 2001, Schedule 1, Clause 2 and eligibility criteria

1.0 Rules

a All at-cost treatment must have prior approval. The amount we contribute is based on the treatment type and is decided by the dental units in the service centres.

Pre-approval decisions must be based on clinical evidence about the need for the treatment and supporting diagnostics.
