

Extend Fatal Weekly Compensation - Child



Summary

Objective

To extend a fatal weekly compensation payment for a child accidental death claimant between the ages of 18 and 21.

Background

A child accidental death claimant over the age of 18 and under the age of 21 may be eligible to continue receiving fatal weekly compensation payments if they are continuing or enrolling in full time study.

If a child is about to turn 18 the procedure is triggered 12 weeks prior to their 18th birthday.

If a child is aged between 18 and 21, and are currently in full time study, the procedure is triggered 12 weeks prior to the cessation of their current full time study period.

If a child is aged between 18 and 21, and is not currently in full time study, they may apply to have their accidental death weekly compensation reinstated for any period that they enroll in full time study.

Procedure	0
1.0 Confirm Intent to study Cover Assessor	

- a Generate the relevant letter and form to be sent to the child accidental death claimant, on receipt of the applicable task.
 - NOTE What do you send to a child accidental death claimant who is about to turn 18, or is 18-21 and is currently in or out of full time study?

Generate an ACD124 Full time study intention - party letter and an ACC6254 Intention to study full time form.

- ACC6254 Intention to study full time
- ACD124 Full time study intention party

b Send the generated letter and form to the child accidental death claimant for documentation completion and to send it back if they intend to study full time.

NOTE What if a child accidental death claimant who is turning 18 does not intend to study full time, or does not return their documentation stating their intent to study full time?

Send the accidental death claimant an ACD127 Entitlements ending reminder - party letter, selecting option 3, informing them that their fatal weekly compensation payment will cease on the 31st of December.

This process ends.

ACD127 Entitlements ending reminder

NOTE What if a child accidental death claimant is aged 18-21, and who is currently studying full time, does not intend to continue studying full time, or does not return their documentation stating their intent to study full time?

The child accidental death claimant's fatal weekly compensation payment will cease at the current cessation date in Eos.

Send the child accidental death claimant an 'ACD127 Entitlements ending reminder - party' letter, selecting option 3, informing them that their fatal weekly compensation payment will cease on the date their current full time study is due to end.

This process ends.

ACD127 Entitlements ending reminder

NOTE What if a child accidental death claimant aged 18-21 who is not currently in full time study does not return their documentation stating their intent to study full time, or decides not to study full time? This process ends.

2.0 Extend interim cessation date of client payment

- a In Eos, change the child accidental death claimant's fatal weekly compensation cessation date to two weeks after their course of study is due to begin.
 - Edit a payment period

	NOTE	 What if the child accidental death claimant is aged between 18 and 21 and is not currently receiving an accidental death weekly compensation payment because they are not currently in full time study? Reactivate the child accidental death claimant's fatal weekly compensation payment and set the cessation date to two weeks after their course of study is due to begin. PROCESS Reinstate Weekly Compensation
	NOTE	What if there is more than one dependent receiving weekly compensation? You will need to initiate the payments for approval for all dependents receiving weekly compensation. Clearly specify which dependent(s) entitlement needs to be reprocessed.

	a Send th	ne child accidental death claimant an ACC138 Certificate of attendance.
	NOTE	 What instructions should you include? 1) Ask them to get their place of full time study (ie university, polytechnic, etc.) to complete this to confirm that the claimant has enrolled or re-enrolled for full time study. 2) Return ACC138 Certificate of attendance before their interim cessation date becomes active.
	NOTE	What if you receive the completed ACC138? Proceed to step 5.0.
	NOTE	What if you have not received the completed ACC138? Contact the child accidental death claimant to remind them that their fatal weekly compensation will cease on the in- terim cessation date unless they return the completed ACC138.

	NOTE	What if the child accidental death claimant returned a completed ACC138 between the interim cessration date and the reactivation date? Extend the child accidental death claimant's fatal weekly compensation cessation date to the date their full time study is due to end as noted on the ACC138.
		Any periods between the interim cessation date and the new cessation date that have not been paid will be paid as ar- rears.
	NOTE	What if the child accidental death claimant drops out of full time study prior to their cessation date? Any payments made to the child accidental death claimant that fall beyond the date they dropped out of full time study is treated as an overpayment and may be liable to be repaid to ACC PROCESS Assess Client Overpayment :: Current State
	NOTE	What if there is more than one dependent receiving weekly compensation? You will need to initiate the payments for approval for all dependents receiving weekly compensation. Clearly specify which dependent(s) entitlement needs to be reprocessed.
