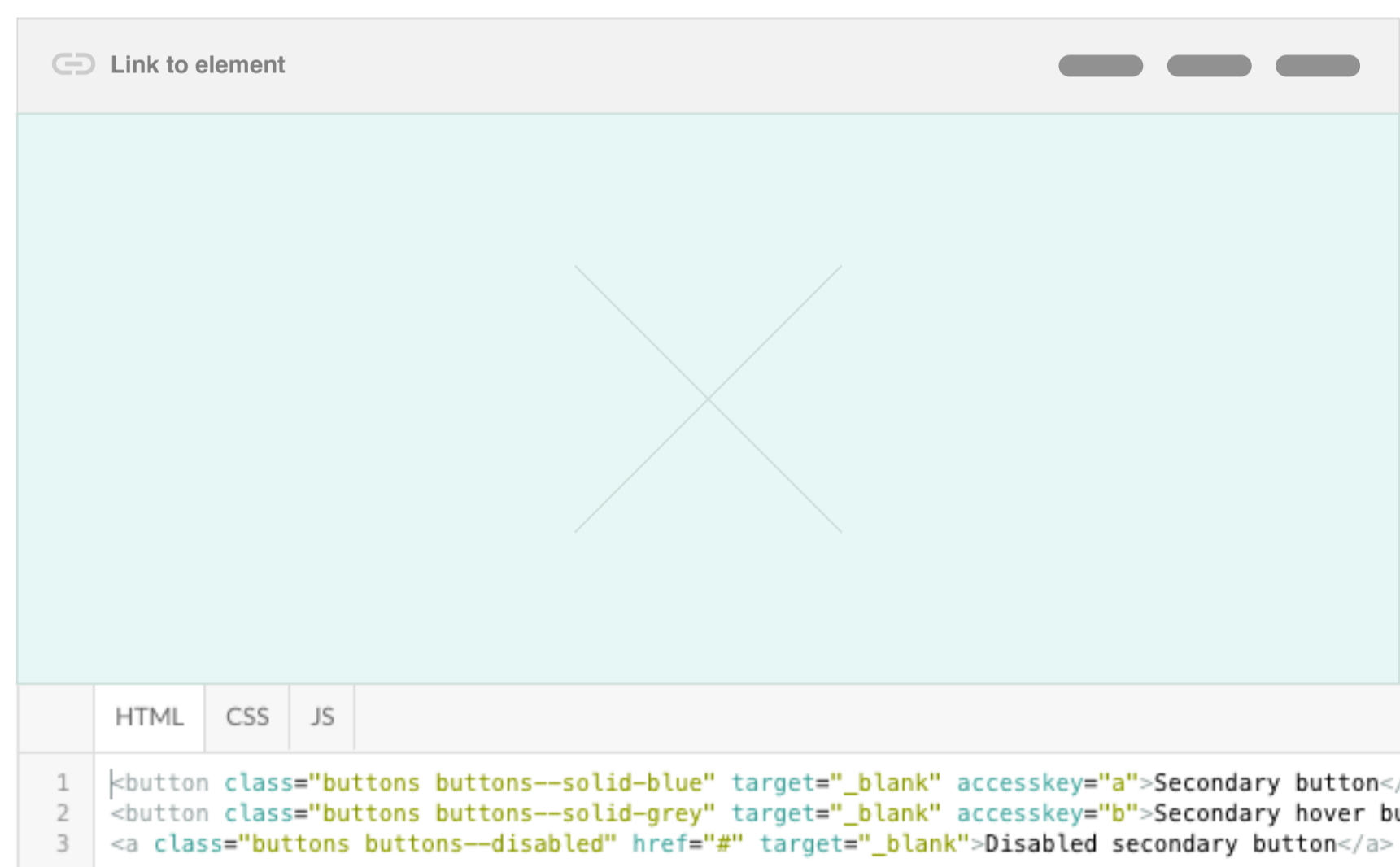

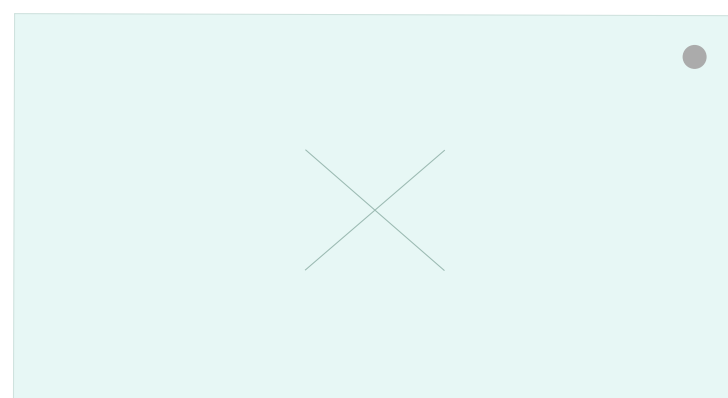

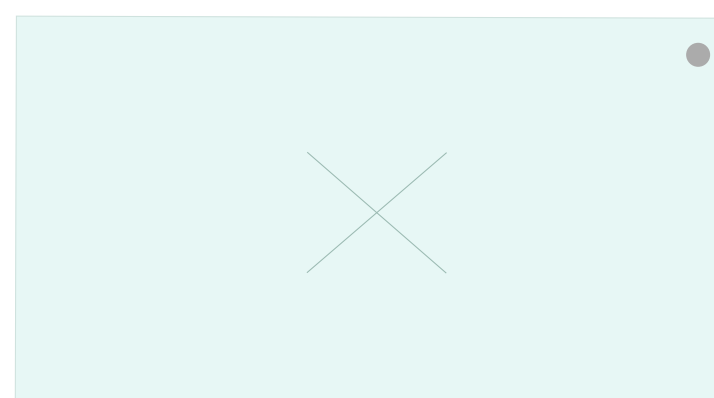

Progress bar

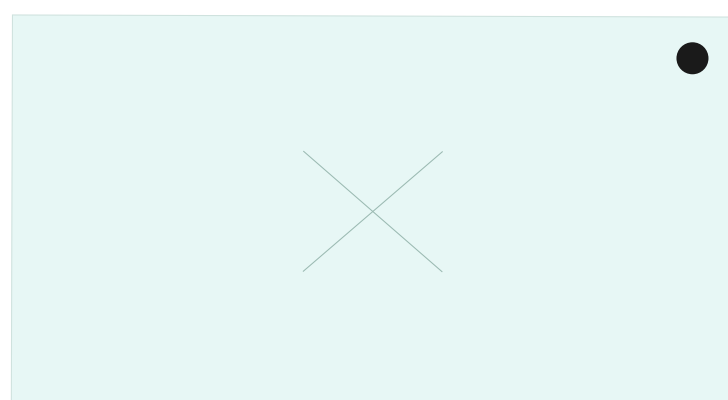

Tag an Object

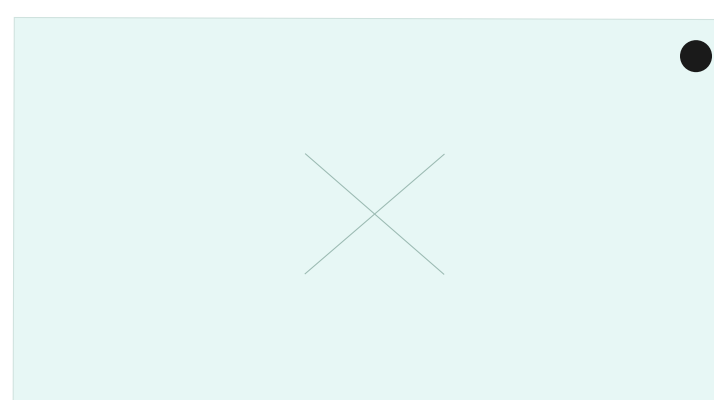
