Your Official Information Act request, reference: GOV-035157

Thank you for your email of 11 September 2024, referring to a data set for dental injury claims caused by treatment and requesting an up-to-date dataset over the past 10 years, under the Official Information Act 1982.

Cover for treatment injuries

A treatment injury is a personal injury caused as a result of seeking or receiving medical treatment from a registered health professional. In order to fulfil the criteria for cover, the person must have suffered a personal injury and there must be a clear causal link between the treatment and the injury, and the injury must not be a necessary part or ordinary consequence of the treatment.

Dental treatment injuries

There were 7,382 dental treatment injury claims decided between 1 July 2014 and 30 June 2024. Of these, 4,806 were accepted for treatment injury cover. Information on these claims is provided in tables 1 to 3 in the appendix. Please refer to the notes provided when reviewing this information.
