Your Official Information Act request, reference: GOV-012185

Thank you for your email of 30 June 2021, asking for the following information under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act):

<u>All new sensitive claims</u> each year, and <u>all active sensitive claims</u>, broken down region, if possible please. Data for 2019 and 2020, and 2021 up until 19^{th} June please.

Our response

Please find attached all new and active sensitive claims lodged with ACC between 1 January 2019 and 9 July 2021.

Notes about the data

When reviewing the attached data, please consider the following notes and caveats.

All tables

- A sensitive claim is a claim for a physical injury or mental injury caused by sexual abuse or assault, as defined by Schedule 3 of the Accident Compensation Act 2001.
- Duplicate claims and claims managed by accredited employers are not included in the data.
- Region is based on the client's residential location when the claim was lodged. This may differ from where the sexual abuse or assault occurs, and from where the client lives now.
- All data is presented in calendar years (1 January 31 December). The 2021 year is year to date (1 January – 9 July 2021).
- Data was extracted on 9 July 2021 and may differ if run at a later date.

Table 1

 New claims: is the count of all new sensitive claims lodged with ACC within the specified timeframe. Claims are counted by the date they are lodged and can be lodged immediately after a client has experienced sexual abuse or assault, or any time after.

Table 2

- Active claims: is the count of sensitive claims that received any payment from ACC in each calendar
 year. These payments are made for any service or support provided by ACC and might include
 medical treatment, therapy and other supports as part of Integrated Services for Sensitive Claims,
 or financial compensation.
- Claims can be active in more than one year, and each claim is counted once in each year where ACC made a payment for the claim.
- Claims receiving Permanent Injury Compensation payments are included in the data. Permanent
 Injury Compensation payments are quarterly or lump sum payments made to clients assessed as
 having a permanent impairment as a result of their covered injury. Clients receiving Permanent
 Injury Compensation may not be receiving any other supports from ACC (such as counselling) and
 therefore the data in this table does not provide an accurate representation of the count of clients
 who were in active treatment in a given calendar year.

Table 3

- Active claims: is the count of sensitive claims that received a payment from ACC in any calendar
 year. These payments are made for any service or support provided by ACC and might include
 medical treatment, therapy and other supports as part of Integrated Services for Sensitive Claims,
 or financial compensation.
- Claims can be active in more than one year, and each claim is counted once in each year where ACC made a payment for the claim.
- Of the Active Claims in the 2020/21 Financial Year, 71% received payment for 10 or more services;
 19% received payment for between 4-9 services, and 10% received payment for between 1-3 services.
- For those Active Claims that received payment for between 1-3 services, 25% of this category only
 received a payment for either a Client non-attendance fee, a Completion Report or a Closure
 Notice. This equates to 2.7% of all Active Claims.
- Excluding Permanent Injury Compensation: is a variation on the active claims measure (as provided in table 2). The data in table 3 excludes any payments for Permanent Injury Compensation as a large number of sensitive claims showing in ACC's system as 'active' are only receiving Permanent Injury Compensation payments and are no longer in active treatment. Therefore, this table provides only the count of claims where ACC is paying for any other support or compensation and can be considered a more accurate count of sensitive claims clients who were in active treatment in a given calendar year.
