Description:

The number of new claims, active claims and active costs for motor vehicle related injuries between 01 January 2014 and 24 October 2024.

Caveats and Notes:

- All claims included have been accepted for cover.
- Claims managed by an accredited employer have been excluded.
- The claim fund is in the 'Motor Vehicle' account.
- Claims have been excluded where the road agency is 'Driving/Passenger - Motorcycle'.
- The accident / payment date is between 01 January 2014 and 24 October 2024.
- Data are displayed in calendar years, i.e. 01 January to 31 December.
- Region is based on the location of the accident and may not be where the client was residing at the time.
- New claims is the count of claims that had an accident during the specified period. The lodgement date may have been lodged any time after the accident occurred.
- Active claims is the count of claims for which ACC made a payment in the specified period. The claim may have been lodged in the specified period or any previous period.
- A claim may be active in multiple periods, and will be counted once in each period it is active. The total number in table 1 is the distinct count of these claims.
- Costs are the GST exclusive cost of payments that were active in the specified period.
- Costs do not include Public Health Acute Services (PHAS) payments. Treatment for covered claims in public hospitals is provided by an annual service agreement between ACC and the Ministry of Health, and is funded by bulk payments from ACC to the Crown.
- The calendar year in which the service was paid may differ to the calendar year in which the service was provided.
- Please note that for the road agency fields of Cycling and ATV, these don't necessarily represent all claims involving bicycles and ATVs, as claims involving these vehicles aren't included in the Motor Vehicle fund if they don't involve a moving motor vehicle on a public road.
- Data were extracted on 25 October 2024 and may differ if re-run at a later date.
