1. *Please provide relevant section of the Act/policy that describes ACC's travel contribution (29 cents per kilometre for private transport)*
2. *When did this begin?*
3. *When did ACC last increase this rate (if at all)*

As this information is publicly available we are not including it with this response. This decision is made with reference to section 18(d) of the Act.

Last ACC mileage rate increase

In response to questions two and three, the current mileage reimbursement was last adjusted on 1 October 2010, increasing from 28 cents per kilometre.
