Your Official Information Act request, reference: GOV-028140

Thank you for your email of 2 October 2023, asking for the following information under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act):

I need some data about shared e-scooters and shared bikes.

That would be great if I can have data about the number of claims, cost to date, per year from 2021 to present (the latest available).

Please advise if we can have data specifically for shared ones. If not, e-scooter and e-bike would be ok.

I need these data for Wellington City, Auckland, and Christchurch.

The requested information is attached in the appendix

When interpreting the data provided, please refer to 'Notes' tab.

We are unable to filter our data by 'shared' e-scooters or e-bikes

This is because information outlining whether an E-scooter or E-bike was privately owned or rented/shared is not collected by ACC nor generally mentioned in the accident description of these claims. Therefore, we are refusing to provide this data as it is not held by ACC. This decision has been made under section 18(g)(i) of the Act.

Description:

The number of new claims, active claims and active costs for e-scooter and e-bike claims from 1 January 2021 to 17 October 2023

Caveats and Notes:

- All claims are accepted for cover.
- Accredited employer claims have been excluded.
- The claim lodgement / payment date is between 01 January 2021 and 17 October 2023.
- E-scooter related claims are found where the accident description includes one of the following words, with some variation:

- battery powered scooter - flamingo scooter

- beam scooter - green scooter - electric scooter - lime scooter - electronic scooter - neuron scooter - e-scooter - uber scooter

- E-bike related claims are found where the accident description includes one of the following words, with some variation:
 - battery powered bike
 - e-bike
 - electric bike
 - electronic bike
- New claims is the count of claims that were lodged with ACC in the specified period. The lodgement date may be any date after the accident occurred.
- Active claims is the count of claims for which ACC made a payment to in the specified period. The claim may have been lodged in the specified period or any previous period.
- A claim may be active in multiple periods, and will be counted once in each period it is active.
- Costs are the GST exclusive.
- Please note that Public Health Acute Services (PHAS) payments are not/cannot be provided/included. These costs are for treatment of ACC claims in a public hospital in the acute phase for a covered injury. These costs are paid through bulk payments that ACC make to the Crown. The services are provided under an annual service agreement between the Ministry of Health and ACC.
- Region is based on the location of the accident and may not be where the client was residing at the time.
- Data were extracted on 18 October 2023 and may differ if extracted again at a later date.
