Your Official Information Act request, reference: GOV-027544

Thank you for your email of 4 September 2023, asking for the following information under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act):

I wish to formally lodge an information request regarding any data you have relating to common injuries from 'Appearance Industries'. Appearance industries include (but are not limited to): Beauty Therapists, Skin Piercers, Nail Salons, Tattooists and (non-surgical) cosmetic procedures. The information I am seeking is:

- 1. How many claims have been lodged which relate to 'Appearance Industry premises' (refer to above outline of who this refers to) between 1 July 2018 and 30 June 2023 (5 year period).
- 2. Of any claims received, can a breakdown be provided as to who the claims were from E.g. District Health Boards, Private surgical facilities, Primary health care associations etc.
- 3. For any claims received, can a breakdown (or estimate) of costs (compensation) be detailed per type of claim/type of appearance industry? E.g. compensation for claims against tattooists, skin piercers, beauty therapists etc specifically

The data requested is provided in the attached spreadsheet

When interpreting the data provided, please refer to the 'Notes' tab.

Claim counts fewer than four

Some of the values in the tables only indicate that the number is less than 4 (denoted as <4). In other instances, values are supressed and denoted as two dots (..). This limits the potential for particular individuals, or matters specific to certain individuals, from being identified.

This decision has been made under section 9(2)(a) of the Act. In doing so, we have considered the public interest in making the information available and have determined that it does not outweigh the need to protect our clients' privacy.

The number of claims for beauty industry from 1 July 2018 to 30 June 2023

Response

The claim lodgement / payment date is between 1 July 2018 and 30 June 2023 $\,$

The claim cover decision is equal to 'Accept'.

The accident description contains one of the following with some variations:

- Laser/IPL hair removal
- Laser tattoo removal
- Manicure / Pedicure
- Exfoliation
- Sun-beds
- Tattooing
- Traditional tools tattooing
- Body piercing
- Acupuncture

Caveats and Notes:

- A financial year is 1 July to 30 June.
- Accredited employer claims have been excluded.
- Costs provided are GST exclusive.

Public Health Acute Services (PHAS) payments have been excluded. These costs are for treatment of ACC claims in a public hospital in the acute phase for a covered injury. These costs are paid through bulk payments that ACC make to the Crown and therefore cannot be attributed to individual claims.

- costs are paid through bulk payments that ACC make to the Crown and therefore cannot be attributed to individual claims.

 The accident description is not mandatory to complete and not every client does so. When the field is completed, the accuracy and level of detail provided varies significantly. Therefore, the data provided should be considered indicative only.
- New claims is the count of claims that were lodged with ACC in the specified period. A claim can be lodged immediately after and injury or at a later date.
- Active claims is the count of claims for which ACC made a payment in the specified period. The claim may have been lodged in the specified period or any previous period.
- The financial year in which the service was paid may differ to the financial year in which the service was provided.

Data were extracted on 22 September and may differ if rerun at a later date.
